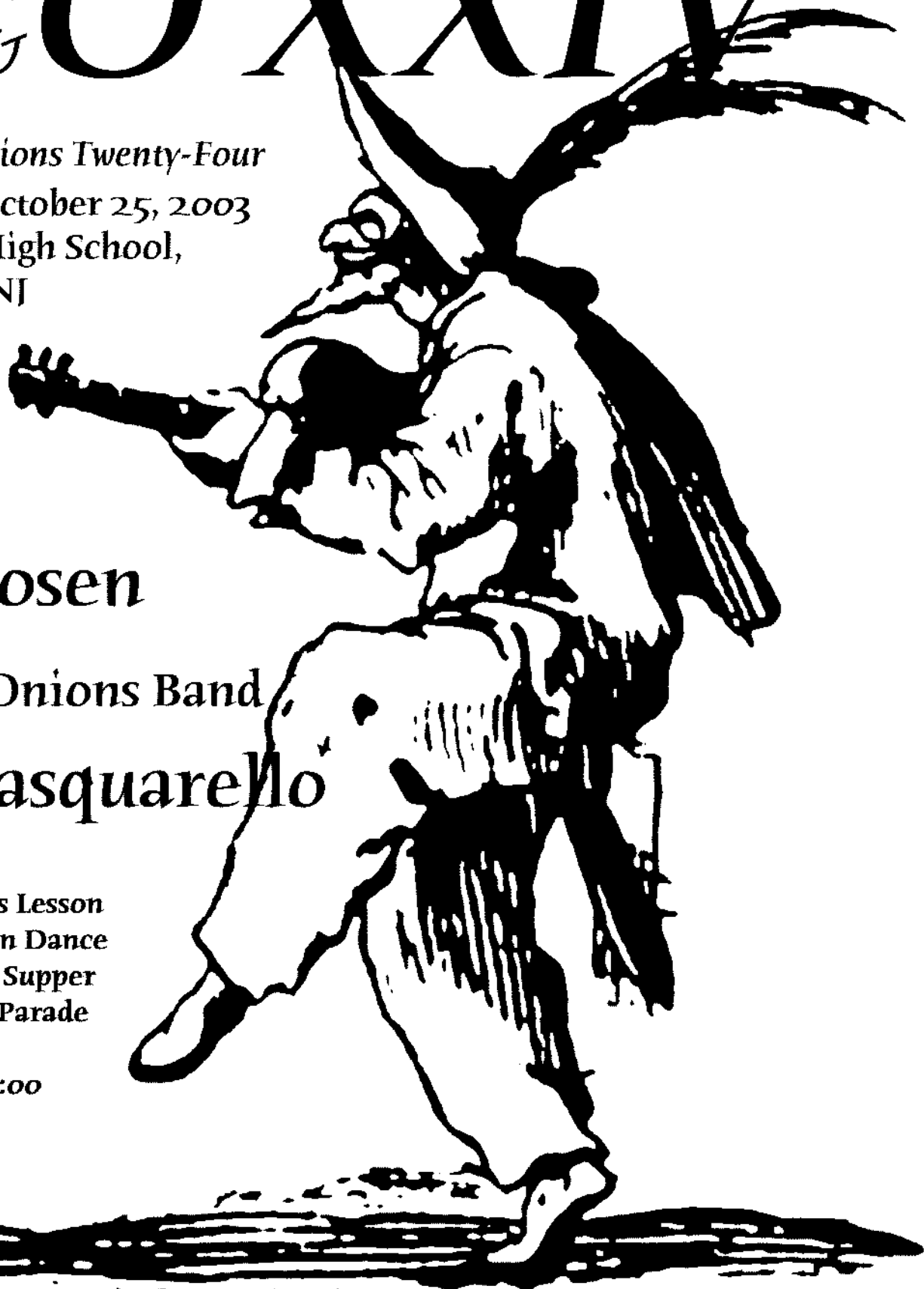

Sue Rosen - A leading caller of contras, squares, and family dance programs, Sue has been actively calling for years in the Boston area, the hottest contra dance spot in the country. She's been dancing all her life and has written dances that have travelled the world, becoming part of the standard contra dance repertoire of numerous callers. Dancers of all levels will enjoy Sue's clear teaching and spirited calling. Sue has led dancing and dance workshops at Berea Christmas School, Cambridge VFW Thursday night dance, Pinewoods camps, and many others, and chaired NEFFA in the early 1980s.

Bob Pasquarello is a major musical force in the mid-Atlantic contra dance scene as a musician, composer, publisher, and band leader. His new book and CD on contra dance piano playing, *Fingers Dancing*, was published in the spring of 2003. A member of A Band Named Bob, he has also made several solo piano recordings of waltzes and English country dance tunes. Bob is a prolific composer and his "afterwaltzes" are eagerly awaited by dancers across the country. He led R&O X-XV and XX-XXIII, and we are delighted to have him back on the podium.

Location:

Princeton High School is on Walnut Lane in Princeton NJ. Look for R&O signs at the Gym entrance.

- From Somerville: Take Route 206 south to Princeton. After passing Route 518, continue 3 miles and turn left at the third traffic light, Cherry Hill Road. Turn right at the T/stop sign, and turn left at the traffic light onto Valley Road. Go three blocks, and turn right onto Walnut Lane. Princeton High School is about a mile down Walnut Lane, on the right.
- From the NJ Turnpike: Take exit 8 and go EAST on Route 33 about 1/4 mile to Route 133 (Hightstown bypass). Take Route 133 west to the end, and bear right onto Route 571 west. Cross Route 1 at the traffic circle and continue straight onto Washington Road. * Take Washington Road west into Princeton. At the 5th light, turn right onto Nassau Street (Route 27). Follow Nassau to the next traffic light and turn left onto Chestnut Street. ** Chestnut becomes Walnut when it crosses Hamilton Avenue at a stop sign. Two blocks past Hamilton, Princeton High School is on the left.
- From Route 1: exit at Washington Road (Route 571). Take Washington Road west into Princeton to the 5th traffic light and turn right on Nassau Street, then follow the directions from "**", above.
- From I-295 or I-95: Take exit 7 for Route 206 north. Go north about 6 miles on Route 206. After lights at Elm Road and Library Place, go straight ahead (at the third light) onto Nassau Street, Route 27 (while Route 206 turns left). Continue on Nassau St. for about 2/3 mile to Chestnut Street (4th traffic light on Nassau Street). Turn left onto Chestnut, and follow the directions from "****", above.
